

NIF Membership Criteria Standards:

The Network of Iraqi Facilitators is glad to welcome new members. To be accepted in as a member of the Network of Iraqi Facilitators, it is important to comply with the membership criteria.

Membership criteria of the network of Iraqi Facilitators:

The Membership criteria for the Network of Iraqi Facilitators is classified under three fundamental groups:

- 1. **Core group:** consists of highly experienced members in conflict managements and dialogue facilitating, and those who are compliant to credence standards.
- 2. **Associate group:** consists of members who are busy with other projects to implement enough projects on peacebuilding.
- 3. **Support group:** consists of members that have religious, tribal, or social leading attributes, and have the ability to prepare the appropriate conditions to carry out negotiations and dialogue.

Membership criteria standards:

- Core group membership criteria standards:
- 1. Signing the MoU between Sanad and the NIF members.
- 2. The commitment of the members to stay clear from any political affiliation.
- 3. Presenting a record confirms the implementation of at least three projects in the period of (2011-2013). Those projects should be related to peacebuilding or conflict management.
- 4. Presenting a record confirms participation in the Advanced Conflict Management Training courses.
- 5. Participating in about 80% of summed activities made in period of (2011-2013) in regional meetings and conferences of the network.
- 6. Participating in 80% of the regional meetings and conferences related to NIF in 2014.
- 7. Presenting a record confirming implementation at least two of peacebuilding/conflict management projects during 2014.
- 8. Providing reports needed from Sanad for peacebuilding organization.
- Associate group membership criteria standards:
- 1. Signing the MoU between Sanad and the NIF members



- 2. The commitment of the members to stay clear from any political affiliation
- 3. Participating in conflict analysis training courses (on the website)
- 4. Participating in conflict analysis of religions training courses (on the website)
- 5. Presenting a record confirms having a leading role in working in the of Iraqi civil society peacebuilding/conflict resolving field.
- Support group membership criteria standards:
- 1. Making at least one research on peacebuilding/conflict management during 2014, or presenting a record document confirming implementation of at least one project related directly to peacebuilding and/or conflict management during 2014
- 2. Providing the logistic and coordinating support for the regional meetings concerning the network.
- 3. Participating in the basic training course in conflict management since organized in 2014
- 4. Participating in conflict analysis training course since organized in 2014
- 5. Presenting needed reports from Sanad for peacebuilding organization.
- 6. Participating in 50% the regional meeting and conferences of the network held in 2014.
