

Enhancing the Values of Peaceful Co-existence between the IDPs and the Host Community

Description

A set of dialogic sessions are to be held, gathering both sides, the IDPs' representatives on one hand, and representative from other local and social host community in Maysan-Iraq on the other. These dialogic sessions discuss several issues, including:

- Social aspects.
- Peaceful coexistence and violence rejection.
- Reconciliation
- Human rights.
- Causes of Internal displacement.
- Legal concerns of the IDPs.
- Health care.
- Problem-resolving commissions formation.
- Educational issues concerning the IDPs.

In which civil society leaders, province council members and tribe leaders in Maysan province are attending these sessions.

Facilitator(s)

The member of the Network of Iraqi Facilitators, Mr.**Ali Badir Abdullah** is committing to carry out and direct these sessions.

Purpose

The main purpose of the project is to enhance the principles of integration, peaceful co-existence, and spreading peace entity among the IDPs, through reaching the specific goals, which are

- A- Strengthening the relationship between the internally displaced families and the host community of Maysan Province, and coordinating the organizational efforts to be developed to circa 30% of the existing efforts within 60 days.
- B- To enhance co-existence values between IDPs and the host community of Maysan within 60 days.
- C- Changing the stereotypical convictions about the internally displaced people, and activating the role of the facilitator to spread peace within 60 days by solving the recent issues.

Implementation period

60 days, January 2nd. 2015 as a starting date for the implementation, and March 2nd, 2015 as the ending day.

Sides of the conflict

- 1- A group of internally displaced people in Maysan province.
- 2- Host community. (i.e. members of the provincial council, representatives from the education department of Maysan, Human right's bureau representative, representative from the general company of foodstuff trading, general inspector of ministry of trade in Maysan, the media, and civil society leaders in Maysan).

Outcome

- 1- Enhancing the disposition to peace and harmony between IDPs and the host community, while spreading peace concepts and abandoning sectarian escalations.
- 2- Reaching out for the IDPs of different categories pointing out the importance of their role in social integration by this, enhancing the role of the facilitator to unfold such concepts.
- 3- Having a group of families who have acquired the full knowledge of their rights and been encouraged to raise the sense of unity of the Iraqi nation, and to trust civil society's capabilities in enforcing the self-esteem of the affected groups of the IDPs.
