

Raising the Spirit of Cooperation and Solidarity for Peace between Host and Guest Communities in Karbala Province

Description

The concept of the project is to strengthen the relationships between host and guest communities in Karbala province through two phases represented in two dialogic sessions that take place within the attendance of impactful internally displaced figures, and representatives of different segments of Karbala society (i.e. clerks, academics, educators, the media, tribal leaders, and provincial council members). These sessions aim to dialogue facilitation, opening communication channels and raise awareness towards peace, harmony and unity in the Iraqi public.

Facilitator(s)

The member of the Network of Iraqi Facilitators, Dr. **Haider Younus Kadhum** is committed to carry out and direct these sessions.

Purpose

The main purpose of the project is:

- A- Facilitate dialogues among the host and guest community.
- B- Raising awareness towards peacebuilding and maintaining cooperation to develop host society's sense of perception regarding the guest community of the internally displaced, affected families in Karbala province.
- C- Coming up with an assortment of services and actions that would be useful in adhering the links between the host and guest community.

Implementation period

January 16th, 2015 is appointed to be the starting date for the implementation period, and March 1st, 2015 as the closing date for the period.

Sides of the conflict

- 1- Internally displaces people in Karbala province.
- 2- Host community (i.e. clerks, academics, educators, the media, tribal leaders, and provincial council members).

Outcome

- 1- Exchanging ideas on the suffering IDPs have been facing with the local community of Karbala province.
- 2- Raising awareness towards peacebuilding and the concepts of harmony and fit between the host and local community.
- 3- Coming up with an assortment of services and actions that would be useful in adhering the links between the host and guest community.
