

Mitigating the Tension among IDPs in Kirkuk Province.

Description

Considering the complications faced by the unregistered Internally Displaced families by the ADRID of Kirkuk province, it is a good opportunity to facilitate dialogues among IDPs (both registered and unregistered) from one side, and making dialogue seminars on the other sides between IDPs and the ADRID to mitigate the tension between both sides and to look up the issues faced by the IDPs, by representing affordable action by the provincial council of Kirkuk. The project is intended to be carried out with four dialogue seminars for the full period of the project.

Facilitator(s)

The member of the Network of Iraqi Facilitators, Mr. **Hasan Khulaif Salih** is committed to carry out and direct these sessions.

Purpose

The main purpose of the project is to mitigate the tension resulting between IDPs in Kirkuk province, through holding dialogue seminars among the IDPs on one side and the official institutions of the province with the humanitarian organizations on the other. The project's period is one month, consisting of four dialogue seminars.

Implementation period

December 20th, 2014 is appointed to be the starting date for the implementation period, and January 10th, 2015 as the closing date for the period.

Sides of the conflict

- 1- Internally displaced people in Kirkuk province.
- 2- ADRID, local government, and humanitarian organizations in Kirkuk province.

Outcome

To be in touch with the bad conditions the IDPs in Kirkuk province are suffering from, and finding satisfactory solutions through providing IDPs with aids, deliver them the allocated grant by the government, and building housing camps for the IDPs.
